Please ask at the front desk of your hotel whether they offer a shuttle bus to the lake. If not, you can either take the local bus to the train station or take a stroll down. The escalator from the top of the Serletta car park (near Badrutt's Palace Hotel) to the lake offers a convenient short-cut.

Parking while near the lake

Driving and parking on the lake is strictly prohibited.

Please, use the «Serletta» underground car park near the train station. It is located less than 100 meters from the entry to our premises.

Access to the lake

Our premises are open to the public free of charge, including access to the stands.
